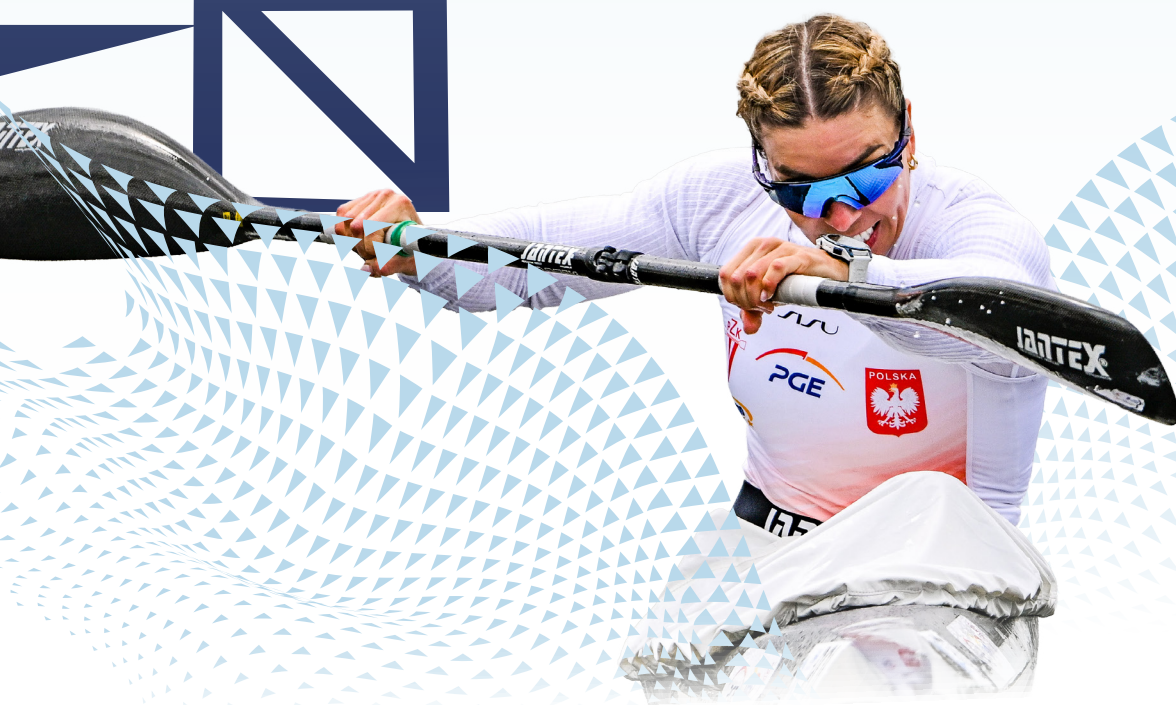

LOCATION

Poland is a country located in Central Europe, bordered by Germany to the west; the Czech Republic and Slovakia to the south; Ukraine and Belarus to the east; and the Baltic Sea to the north. The total area of Poland is approximately 312,700 square kilometers (about 120,700 sq mi). With a population of over 38 million people, Poland is a member of the European Union and the Schengen Area.

Poland is a unitary parliamentary republic. According to available indices, it ranks among the more peaceful countries

in Europe. The President, elected by popular vote every five years, is the head of state. The Prime Minister, appointed on the basis of parliamentary majority, heads the government - the parliamentary term lasts up to four years.

Since 1999 Poland has been divided for administrative purposes into 16 voivodeships (provinces), further subdivided into 314 counties (powiats) including cities with county rights, and 2,478 municipalities (gminas).

GETTING TO POZNAN



Poznań is served by Poznań-Lawica Henryk Wieniawski Airport (POZ), located only 7 km from the city centre and around 20 minutes from the regatta venue at Lake Malta.

The airport offers direct connections to major European cities, including: Frankfurt, Munich, Amsterdam, London, Paris, Copenhagen, and Dublin. It is well connected with international hubs, making transfers from intercontinental flights quick and convenient.

BY CAR/BUS

You can get to Poznań driving A2 motorway, national routes no. 92, 5 (east - west direction) and no. 11 (north - south). Access from the west direction: from Berlin 270 km, from Nowy Tomysl - 108 km, where national route no.2 is connected with the motorway to Warsaw - a charge is payable for using it.

AIRPORT - HOTEL - AIRPORT

Transfers between the airport and official hotels are available for teams at an additional cost of **€35** per person (one way).

Poznan

Poznań is one of Poland's oldest and most vibrant cities, located halfway between Warsaw and Berlin. Known for its rich history, colorful Old Town, and iconic billy goats appearing daily on the Renaissance Town Hall tower, the city combines cultural heritage with modern energy.

The picturesque Malta Lake, home to the regatta course, is a popular recreation area surrounded by parks, walking paths, and sports venues. Poznań offers a thriving cultural scene with museums, theaters, art galleries, and music festivals throughout the year.

MALTA



Malta Lake in Poznań is one of the city's **most popular leisure and recreation areas**. Surrounded by parks, walking and cycling paths, it offers a variety of attractions such as an all-year ski slope, thermal baths, a zoo, and an adventure park. The area hosts numerous cultural and sporting events, concerts, and family festivals, creating a vibrant space that combines nature, sport, and entertainment in the very heart of Poznań.



The history of the regatta course on Lake Malta dates back to 1917, when a group of patriotic Poznań residents announced a competition for a sports center for youth. It was no coincidence that the Malta area was chosen – it was here, during the Prussian occupation, that the youth of Poznań gathered to practice various sports under the guidance of "Sokół" instructors. Unfortunately, it took nearly 35 years for this vision to become a reality. In 1952, the Malta hosted large international rowing and canoeing regattas, held as part of the Youth and Student Festival.

The venue immediately gained recognition, primarily due to its unique and almost perfect location – the regatta basin is situated nearly in the city center, on the edge of expansive green areas. Numerous hotels and student dormitories ensure a variety of accommodation and dining options, and Poznań, as a city known for traditional international fairs, offers excellent transport connections to all of Europe and the world.

As the regatta course eventually no longer met international standards for holding rowing and canoeing competitions, a major modernization was carried out between 1981 and 1990, including deepening the entire lake, reinforcing the shores, and building new facilities to support the course. This modernization was made possible thanks to the persistence of a small group of activists, led by the then-President of the City of Poznań, Andrzej Wituski.

The plans were executed based on the concept, designs, and supervision of a former athlete – a rower from the Academic Sports Association in Poznań, a Polish Rowing Champion – architect Klemens Miłucha. His years of experience as a competitive rower, who competed on various courses and under different conditions, are particularly evident in the functionality and equipment of the facilities for athletes, judges, and course staff. It is no surprise, then, that the venue is not only beautiful but, above all, highly functional today.

ENTRIES

The Malta Regatta Course will be open for national teams wishing to organize training camps prior to the 2026 ICF Canoe Sprint & Paracanoe World Championships.

The Organizing Committee offers comprehensive training conditions, including:

- > full access to the regatta course,
- > training sessions on the starting system (available Monday to Friday, 1 hour per day),
- > 1 motorboat available for team coaches,
- > access to boat storage areas and changing rooms,
- > a fully equipped gym on-site.

Accommodation with full board (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) can be arranged through the official partners of the Organizing Committee, ensuring high standards of comfort and convenience.

TIP Programme

The ICF Talent Identification Programme (TIP) develops young athletes, especially from developing countries, through training camps, technical support, and high-performance experience. This year, part of the programme will take place during the 2026 ICF Canoe Sprint and Paracanoe World Championships in Poznan, aiming to prepare 30 athletes for the Los Angeles Olympic Games.

Host Organizing Committee Services

PARTICIPATION FEE

In case accommodation is booked **NOT** through the Organizing Committee you are required to pay the Participation Fee.

Every participant (athletes, coaches, team Staff etc.) will be charged a Participation Fee of **30€** per person per day from the day of arrival (no earlier than 22.08.2026) until the departure day (no later than 31.08.2026).

This option covers the cost of access period since day of arrival, allowing participants to arrange their own accommodation, meals, and transportation.

CATERING/LUNCH

Teams are advised that foods suitable for special dietary needs (e.g., gluten-free, lactose-free, vegan) will be provided during meals.

All key allergens (nuts, lactose, gluten, shellfish, fish) will be clearly labeled.

Special dietary requests for lunch will be accommodated upon prior notification, which must be submitted at paddlepoznan@gmail.com no later than 26.07.2026

Please note that additional charges may apply for these requests.
